PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

William Slim Drive currently experiences considerable congestion, particularly in the morning peak, with around 20,000 vehicle movements daily.

An upgrade of William Slim Drive to a dual carriageway between Ginninderra Drive and the Barton Highway is required to support housing development in the area, reduce congestion and improve safety. The works will include intersection upgrades at Dumas Street, Owen Dixon Drive and Chuculba Crescent.

- **Ensure forecast population-driven increases in travel demand are met.**
