### PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

Melbourne is Australia's fastest growing capital city and suburbs in Melbourne's south-east and north are some of the fastest growing in Australia.

The Suburban Roads Upgrades - South Eastern Roads and Northern Roads project involves the upgrade of selected suburban roads in Melbourne's south-east and north.

These upgrades are expected to reduce congestion and increase the safety and reliability of the suburban road network across Melbourne's south-east and north to support the city's growing population.

This project is expected to be funded on a 50:50 basis with the Victorian Government.
