Oats Street/Welshpool Road/Mint Street Level Crossing Removal

State/Territory: Western Australia

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

There are currently 31 vehicle level crossings on the Perth rail network. These level crossings can cause significant safety issues resulting from the interfaces between pedestrians, passenger vehicles and the expanding Perth rail network. They have resulted in a high number of traffic incidents at boom gates and adjacent road intersections.

As the Perth rail network expands and new rail lines and trains become operational, there is a greater need to remove these level crossings and improve the safety and efficiency of the network.

The project will involve removal of the Oats Street (Carlisle) level crossing, as well as the nearby Welshpool Road (Welshpool) and Mint Street (East Victoria) level crossings. The project is estimated to support approximately 700 direct and indirect jobs.

This project is expected to be funded on a 50:50 basis with the Western Australian Government.
