Project description

This project involves construction of a bypass of inner city Newcastle. The bypass will be built between Rankin Park and Jesmond, to the west of John Hunter Hospital. It will provide traffic relief to the surrounding road network.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 900 direct and indirect jobs.

- Improved efficiency and network reliability.
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times.
- Improved connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets.
- Improved road safety for all road users.
