## Australian Government Funding: \$176.2 million

New South Wales Government contribution: \$44.0 million  
Total: \$220.2 million

## Project description

This project involves construction of a new bridge over the Macquarie River in Dubbo, the construction of a new 2.3 kilometre link road between Thompson Street and Bourke Street, and associated intersection upgrades. It will ease congestion and maintain reliable access through Dubbo during flood events.

## Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 290 direct and indirect jobs.

## Project benefits

Benefits include:

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved efficiency and network reliability.
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks.
- Improved freight productivity and access to freight gateways.

## Project timelines

- This project is expected to start in late 2022 and be finished by mid 2025.
