Project description

The project will upgrade a 3.6 km section of the Prospect highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to a four-lane divided carriageway, with the section north of Lancelot Street to be upgraded to a six-lane divided road, inclusive of two dedicated bus lanes, and improvements to 11 intersections along the route.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 490 direct and indirect jobs.

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times.
- Improved efficiency and network reliability.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start in mid 2021 and be finished by mid 2024.
