Broome-Cape Leveque Road: Upgrading and Community Access Roads

Project description

The project will reconstruct the first approximately 15 km of the Broome-Cape Leveque Road and support sealing of community access roads. It will also upgrade the intersection at the Broome Highway.

This project also complements the Australian Government's \$52.5 million commitment under the Northern Australia Roads Program towards a 90 km seal of the Broome-Cape Leveque Road.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 90 direct and indirect jobs.

Project benefits

Benefits include:

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved efficiency and network reliability.
- Improved connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start in early 2021 and be finished by mid 2022.
