Project description

The Goldfields Highway between Wiluna and Meekatharra section is 180 km long, of which, 125 km remains unsealed resulting in low levels of service for freight transport, resources and tourism industries and general road users.

The project will construct and seal 17 km of the Goldfields Highway between Wiluna and Meekatharra at two priority locations.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 100 direct and indirect jobs

Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved efficiency and network reliability.
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start in early 2021 and be finished by mid 2022.
