## Project description

This project involves improvements to William Hovell Drive, including the duplication of remaining sections of the road between the intersection of John Gorton Drive in the east to Drake Brockman Drive to the northwest. Upgrades also include on-road cycle lanes and an off-road shared path.

With the growing residential areas in Ginninderry and West Belconnen, these upgrades will ensure connectivity, reduce congestion and improve road safety for all road users.

- This project is expected to support 176 direct and indirect jobs
