### Project description

The project includes:

- The M5 Westbound Traffic Upgrade which provides a new two lane bridge over Georges River and rail line, connecting the M5 Motorway and Moorebank Avenue to the Hume Highway. It will also include a new underpass at Moorebank Avenue which will connect M5 Motorway westbound traffic to the Hume Highway, enabling the closure of the M5 westbound Hume Highway exit.
- The M5/Moorebank Avenue intersection upgrade which will widen three of the four interchange ramps.

### Jobs supported

- The project is expected to support 343 direct and indirect jobs

### Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times
- Improved efficiency and network reliability
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks

### Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2022 and be finished construction by mid 2025
