Mount Ousley Interchange

### Australian Government funding: \$240.0 million

New South Wales Government contribution: \$60.0 million

### Project description

This project involves the upgrade of the intersection of the Princes Motorway and Mount Ousley Road.

The interchange will replace the existing intersection, which is a significant pinch point of the Motorway network, and currently experiences long queues and delays during peak periods. As the primary access point to Wollongong and Port Kembla, issues at this intersection also create significant flow-on effects across the transport network.

This project will improve travel times, as well as access to the Wollongong central business district and the University of Wollongong. It will ensure safer access to and from the Motorway to Mount Ousley Road, and improve safety by separating cars and heavy vehicles travelling down Mount Ousley.

### Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 457 direct and indirect jobs

### Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2023 and be finished construction by mid 2026
