### Australian Government funding: \$48.0 million

New South Wales Government contribution: \$12.0 million

### Project description

This project involves constructing a full grade separated interchange at the junction between the Pacific Highway and roads connecting to Harrington and Cooperbrook.

Concerns have been raised about the safety of this intersection, including following a recent fatal accident.

This project will improve road safety at the intersection, ensuring local road users can join the highway more safely. There may also be opportunities to improve flood immunity as part of this upgrade.

- This project is expected to support 120 direct and indirect jobs

- Improved efficiency and network reliability
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times

### Project timelines
