# Infrastructure Investment Program

Princes Highway Corridor (NSW) – Jervis Bay Road Intersection

New South Wales

## Australian Government funding: \$100.0 million

New South Wales Government contribution: \$25.0 million

**Total: \$125.0 million**

## Project description

This project will upgrade the intersection of Jervis Bay Road and the Princes Highway, as part of broader upgrades to the Princes Highway Corridor in NSW. This will include:

- a bridge for highway traffic to cross Jervis Bay Road and travel north on the highway
- longer entry and exit lanes on and off the highway, and
- the construction of two roundabouts to enter/exit highway.

This intersection experiences the highest volume of vehicle movements on the highway between Nowra and the Victorian border, with delays during peak periods and 15 crashes in the past five years, resulting in six serious and 11 minor injuries.

The project will improve safety and reduce congestion at this intersection.

## Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 280 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

## Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved freight productivity
- Improved efficiency and network reliability
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times

## Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2022 and be finished construction by early 2025
