Project description

This is additional funding for the Australian Government’s more than \$10 billion commitment towards the Bruce Highway Upgrade Program and will support the delivery of the next priority upgrades between Gladstone to Rockhampton and Mackay to Proserpine, as determined by the Australian and Queensland governments.

These next priority upgrades will improve safety, efficiency, freight productivity and flood immunity along these key sections of the Bruce Highway.

Jobs supported

- This funding will support projects that are expected to support 610 direct jobs based on Australian Government estimates

Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved freight productivity
- Improved efficiency and network reliability
- Reduced congestion and improved travel times

Project timelines

- This funding will support projects that are expected to start construction in early 2023 and be finished construction by mid 2025
