Project description

The project will undertake pre-construction activities to upgrade the 19km section of existing rail track from Kuraby to Beenleigh. The project will finalise the scope, cost, timing and procurement for the project and undertake community consultation. Upgrading this section is the critical first step in providing faster, more efficient passenger rail services from Brisbane to the Gold Coast.
