Project description

This project is expected to include:

- Duplication of Pialba-Burrum Heads Road to four lanes, between Scrub Hill Road and Maryborough-Hervey Bay Road
- Duplication of Maryborough-Hervey Bay Road from Urraween Road to Pialba-Burrum Heads Road
- Signalisation of the Maryborough-Hervey Bay Road/Pialba-Burrum Heads Road intersection.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 55 direct jobs based on Australian Government estimates

Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in early 2024 and be finished construction by mid 2026
