Project description

This project will deliver a new signalised intersection on Nicklin Way and extend Third Avenue to connect to Nicklin Way. The new four-way signalised intersection on Nicklin Way will be 500 metres north of the existing roundabout at Nicklin Way/Caloundra Road/Pelican Waters Boulevard.

The project will also extend Industrial Avenue to connect to Nicklin Way and upgrade and signalise the intersection of Third Avenue and Arthur Street.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 20 direct jobs based on Australian Government estimates

Project benefits

- Reduced congestion and improved travel times
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start in early 2022 and be finished by mid 2023
