Project description

This project will duplicate the Augusta Highway from Port Wakefield to Lochiel, to improve safety and travel times, and will build on existing investments to duplicate priority sections of the highway from Port Wakefield to Port Augusta. The project will also include planning for future duplication works between Port Pirie and Crystal Brook.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 280 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved freight productivity
- Improved efficiency and network reliability

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2021 and be finished construction by late 2023
