### Project description

This project will include planning, design and construction of approximately 6km of motorway on the North-South Corridor from Darlington to Anzac Highway, including over 4km of tunnels. The project follows previous investments on the North-South Corridor, including the Northern Connector, Torrens Road to River Torrens, Darlington Upgrade and Regency Road to Pym Street projects.

### Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 4000 direct jobs

- Reduced congestion and improved travel times
- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved efficiency and network reliability

### Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2023 and be finished construction by late 2028
