Project description

This project will deliver a bypass of Truro on the Sturt Highway, to improve road safety and productivity of the national network, and to improve the regional connection between Adelaide and the Riverland for freight, tourism and local commuters. It complements works being undertaken as part of the Renmark to Gawler Roads of Strategic Importance corridor.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 555 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2022 and be finished construction by late 2026
