### Project description

This project will provide a link road east of the town centre of Huonville, to divert Hobart - Cygnet traffic from the existing Channel Highway/Huon Highway intersection and Main Street. The link road will directly connect the Channel Highway south of Huonville to the Huon Highway north of Huonville. It will improve traffic flow and enhance pedestrian safety in the town centre and provide traffic a reliable alternative route when part of the Channel Highway is flooded.

### Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 60 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

### Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks
- Improved efficiency and network reliability

### Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in early 2022 and be finished construction by late 2024
