## Midland Highway Upgrade – Oatlands (Jericho to South of York Plains)

Tasmania

### Australian Government funding: \$36.4 million

Tasmanian Government contribution: \$9.1 million  
**Total: \$45.5 million**

### Project description

This project includes road widening, shoulder sealing, additional overtaking lanes and installation of flexible safety barriers on the Midland Highway to improve safety outcomes from Jericho to South of York Plains. The project will improve the safety on the highway and achieve a minimum 3 Star AusRAP Safety Rating.

### Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 170 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

### Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved efficiency and network reliability

### Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in late 2021 and be finished construction by mid 2024
