Project description

This project will deliver upgrades on South Arm Road including intersection upgrades, duplication works and safety improvements along the Rokeby - South Arm Road corridor, between Pass Road and Acton Road in Rokeby, east of Hobart.

- This project is expected to start construction in early 2025 and be finished construction by late 2026
