Project description

The project is expected to include the duplication of Racecourse Road between the Princes Freeway and Henry Street in Pakenham, and the upgrade of the McGregor Road interchange. This includes the signalisation of the intersection at Bald Hill Road, an upgrade of the Princes Freeway overpass, upgrading the McGregor Road interchange with the Pakenham Bypass, new freeway ramps and the widening of McGregor Road between the northern freeway roundabout and Webster Way.

The project will address congestion and cater for growth and accessibility in the Pakenham East, Officer and South East Business Park areas. It is also expected to reduce traffic delays and increase safety for road users on McGregor Road, Racecourse Road and the Princes Freeway.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 940 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

- Improved connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets
- Improved efficiency and network reliability

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in early 2022 and be finished construction by mid 2023
