Project description

The project involves upgrading the Great Eastern Highway at the following locations: Coates Gully, Walgoolan to Southern Cross, and Ghooli to Benari. The upgrade works may involve realignment, widening, bridge replacement or improvement, passing lanes, intersection improvements, rest areas and improvements to drainage.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 450 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates

- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved freight productivity
- Improved efficiency and network reliability

Project timelines

- This project is expected to start construction in early 2022 and be finished construction by mid 2025
