Project description

This project will provide funding for the development of a Final Business Case and early property acquisitions, if required, for an extension of the Sydney Metro Western Sydney Airport line from Bradfield to Glenfield via Leppington. The Final Business Case will provide the detailed design, economic assessment and cost estimation to inform an investment decision for the construction of the extension.
