Project description

The planning study will identify more than 100 road infrastructure improvements to existing flood evacuation routes.

The program will identify key priorities to improve the resilience of the road network to local and flash flooding events and support safe and efficient evacuation from flood affected areas in the Hawkesbury Nepean Valley.

The planning study will provide a plan of works to improve flood evacuation in the region such as road widening, new culvert and bridge structures, road raising, pinch point upgrades and drainage improvements.
