Project description

This planning project is scoping and developing a Picton bypass and priority upgrades to increase the safety and capacity of Picton Road in preparation for construction. Upgrades are likely to include duplication of Picton Road, including median separation and roadside safety barriers between the Hume and Princes motorways, as well as upgrades to the interchanges of Picton Road with these motorways.

The scoped upgrades once delivered will reduce travel times and improve road safety along the corridor for all users, including by reducing the risk of head on and run off road crashes.
