Project description

This project will construct new overpass at the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road intersection in Darwin.

The intersection is one of the busiest in the Northern Territory and has a lot of heavy vehicle traffic. It is the main intersection leading to the Port of Darwin and East Arm Wharf and is one of the main commuter routes into the Darwin CBD. The Northern Territory Government has concept designs for the intersection grade separation, which has been planned for many years. There is complementary road safety work along Berrimah Road with this project which fronts a school and light industrial precinct.

Benefits of this project include conflict elimination, preventing angle crashes resulting in enhanced safety, reducing congestion and improved connectivity for freight transport to East Arm Wharf.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 210 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates.

Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Reduced congestion and improve travel times.
- Improved freight productivity.
- Supporting a more integrated and effective transport system.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to commence construction in mid-2022 and be completed by late 2024.
