### Project description

Under the **South East Queensland City Deal**, the Australian Government, Queensland Government, and Brisbane City Council will investigate enhanced modal integration and transport connectivity to and through South Bank. The project will consider active transport and public realm improvements, with a focus on Brisbane’s cultural precinct, with pedestrian upgrades and amenity improvements.

The project will complement the wider Brisbane Metro project which is delivering new and upgraded busway infrastructure and a new tunnel link in the Central Business District. As part of the Brisbane Metro project, Brisbane City Council is considering upgrades to connectivity at South Bank. This will help to support a more integrated and effective transport system with improved passenger services.
