Project description

Under the **South East Queensland City Deal**, the Australian Government, Queensland Government, and Brisbane City Council will deliver a new metro station at Woolloongabba to improve transport connectivity and reduce congestion.

The Woolloongabba Metro Station is a part of a broader set of works on the Brisbane Metro. The Woolloongabba Metro Station will provide improved access to health and sporting precincts including The Gabba Stadium and the Mater Hospital.

The population in South East Queensland is forecast to grow from 3.7 million in 2021 to 4.9 million in 2036. The Queensland Government estimates 45 per cent of SEQ jobs growth will be concentrated inside the Brisbane metropolitan area. The Woolloongabba Metro Station will provide an important transport connection to these high-growth residential and employment areas.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 1,345 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates.

Project benefits

- Reduced congestion and improved travel times.
- Improved connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets.
- Supporting a more integrated and effective transport system.

Project timelines
