Bruce Highway (Buchanan Road to Caboolture Bribie Island Road) Upgrade – Business Case Queensland

Project description

This project will develop a business case to upgrade the Collector Distributor roads between Buchanan Road and Caboolture Bribie Island Road on the Bruce Highway. The business case will consider a major upgrade to the Caboolture Bribie Island Road interchange with new and upgraded bridges over the Caboolture River, as well as adjoining Caboolture to Steve Irwin Way which is currently under construction.

The business case will set out how the upgrade will support ongoing development and business growth in the key regional centre of Caboolture and provide significant growth in the Caboolture West development area. It will take account of forecasts, which show this section of the highway will be operating at 105% of existing 6-lane capacity by 2031, as well as safety issues that have been identified within the project area.
