### Project description

This planning project will investigate future stages of the Coomera Connector, between Loganholme and Coomera, through a documented staging plan and business case to present an investment decision to governments on the next priority stage for completion. It will complement the current approved project - Coomera Connector Stage 1 between Coomera and Nerang – to which the Australia Government has committed \$1.066 billion.

The full Coomera Connector is a 45 kilometre corridor between Nerang and Loganholme. It will provide a long-term transport solution that will meet current and future population growth in the northern Gold Coast and Logan area and relieve congestion on the M1 Pacific Motorway.
