Project description

This project will upgrade the intersection of Steve Irwin Way and Caloundra Street in Landsborough. The project will improve safety at the intersection by providing traffic signals, modifying the intersection to include appropriate lane configuration and storage lengths, and provision of CCTV cameras.

The project is required in order to reduce the number of crashes arising from insufficient gaps in traffic to make safe movements through the intersection.

- This project is expected to support 28 direct and indirect jobs.

- Reduced congestion and improve travel times.
- Improved efficiency and network reliability.

Project timelines
