## Gore Highway (Millmerran-Goondiwindi): Wyaga Creek Flood Improvement

Queensland

### Australian Government Funding: \$36.19 million

Queensland Government Contribution: \$9.05 million

**Total: \$45.24 million**

### Project description

This project will upgrade the Wyaga Creek crossing on the Gore Highway, north of Goondiwindi, to replace the existing low-immunity culvert with a higher flood immunity bridge structure. The project will also deliver pavement widening and rehabilitation works on the approaches to the new bridge.

The upgrade will improve road safety for all users and well as improving freight efficiency and network reliability by reducing annual of times of closure along this key state road link.
