## Project description

This project includes sealing and floodway upgrades for the Eaglefield Road, in Pasha in Bowen Basin, Queensland.

The Eaglefield Road is an important linking road between the state routes Kilcummin Diamond Downs Road and Suttor Developmental Road. Traffic is anticipated to increase on the Eaglefield Road due to recent sealing works on the adjoining Pasha Road, developing agricultural industries and proximity to a processing facility. Led by Isaac Regional Council, this project will help meet demand by increasing the road's level of service, safety and travel time for heavy vehicles.

This project is funded under the Townsville to Roma Corridor, under the Roads of Strategic Importance initiative. It will provide corridor-level benefits by improving freight connectivity, productivity and safety, and facilitate economic opportunities for various industries including agribusiness, construction, manufacturing and mining.

## Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 5 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates.

## Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved freight productivity and access to freight gateways.
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks.

## Project timelines
