## Project description

This project includes a grade separation of the tram level crossings on Marion Road and Cross Road, widening of the Anzac Highway and Marion Road Intersection, widening of the Cross Road and Marion Road Intersection, pedestrian and cycling access improvements.

This investment would ease of congestion and traffic delay issues, reduce crashes the Marion and Cross Road, and Marion and Anzac intersections. It will also increase safety outcomes for pedestrians crossing Marion Road and moving to and from the Marion Road Tram station, as well as creating faster active transport connections.

## Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 1,071 direct and indirect jobs.

## Project timelines

- This project is expected to commence construction in late 2023 and be completed by mid-2026.
