Project description

This project involves the removal of the road-rail level crossing on Morrison Road by constructing a grade separated crossing. Morrison Road is a significant regional distributor road in the Midland district. Removing this crossing will improve safety by removing the risk of rail-road conflict, and reduce congestion and improve journey time reliability for road users crossing the rail line.

This investment forms part of the Australian Government's over \$3.7 billion commitment to METRONET, which includes over \$440 million in new funding committed at the 2022-23 Budget.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 360 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates.

Project benefits

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Reduced congestion and improve travel times.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to commence construction in mid-2025 and be completed by mid-2027.
