Project description

The project will involve construction of a new grade separated interchange at the intersection of Tonkin Highway and Thomas Road, and the duplication of approximately 2.8 kilometres of Thomas Road east of Tonkin Highway (toward the South Western Highway).

Integrated into this project is approximately 2.8 kilometres of new Principal Shared Path along the southern verge of Thomas Road.

This project will complement related projects in the area, including the Tonkin Highway Stage 3 Extension and the Thomas Road Upgrade, by removing merge points along Thomas Road and reducing congestion bottlenecks.

Jobs supported

- This project is expected to support 525 direct and indirect jobs based on Australian Government estimates.

Project benefits

- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks.
- Reduced congestion and improve travel times.

Project timelines

- This project is expected to commence construction in early 2025 and be completed by mid-2028.
