## Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program

Through the October 2022-23 Budget, the Australian Government is committing to Phase 4 of the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) Program. The LRCI Program supports local councils to deliver priority local roads and community infrastructure projects across Australia, supporting jobs and the resilience of local communities.

This Budget follows a repositioning of infrastructure investment to respond to market capacity constraints, creating a more sustainable infrastructure pipeline while continuing to support priorities for Australian communities.

We are investing an additional \$250 million on top of the previously announced \$500 million, taking the next phase of the LRCI Program to \$750 million. This top up recognises the need to support local communities across Australia, particularly those in regional and remote Australia.

This brings the total Australian Government commitment to the LRCI Program to \$3.25 billion.

So far, the LRCI Program has delivered a broad range of projects, including roads, community halls, parks and sports facilities, bike paths and playgrounds. It has also made existing public facilities more accessible.
