



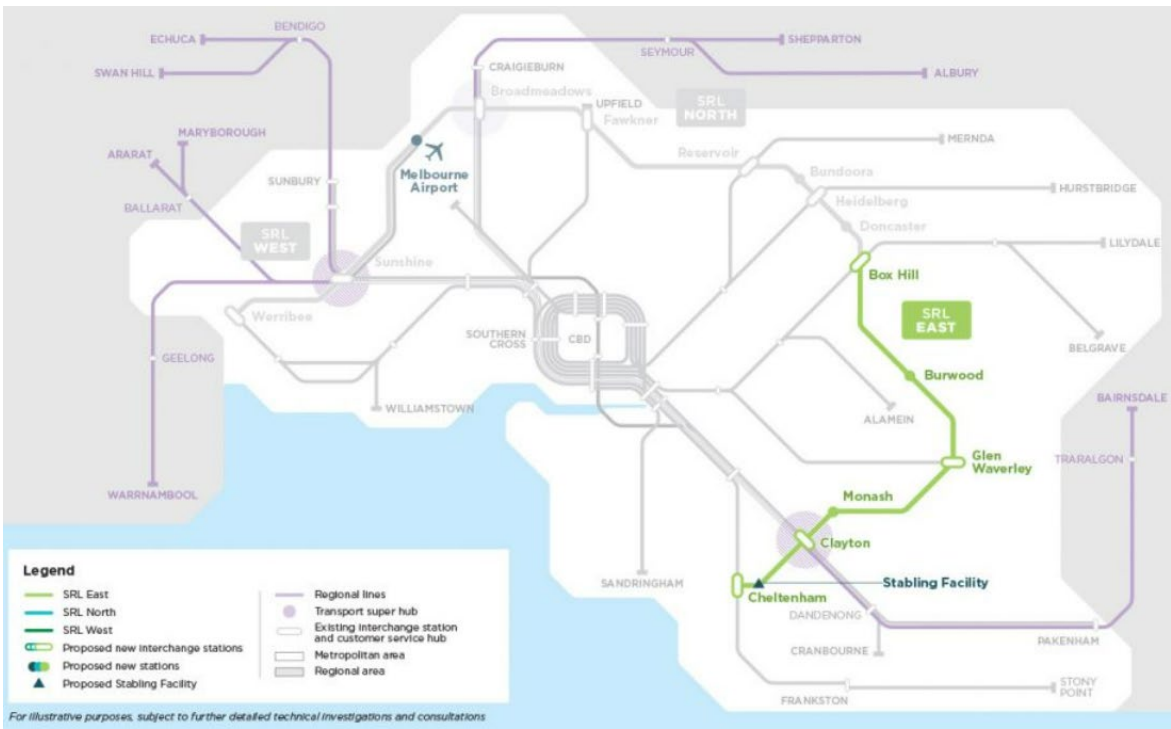
Suburban Rail Loop

The Australian Government is investing \$2.2 billion over five years for the construction of the Suburban Rail Loop East project. The Australian Government’s contribution is in addition to \$11.8 billion from the Victorian Government.

Suburban Rail Loop East is the first section of the Suburban Rail Loop project. It will deliver twin 26 kilometre tunnels, with six underground stations at Cheltenham, Clayton, Monash, Burwood, Glen Waverley and Box Hill.

The Suburban Rail Loop East project will help connect Victorians to key employment, education, retail and health precincts across east and south-east Melbourne.
