New Line Road

State/Territory: New South Wales

Proposed AG funding: \$10.0 million

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will investigate the upgrade of New Line Road to a four lane divided carriageway from the current combination of divided dual carriageway and undivided single carriageway. This would increase capacity to support forecast population growth in Sydney's north west. This investment is expected to be funded on a 50:50 basis with the New South Wales Government.

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

New Line Road extends approximately 6.2 kilometres from Castle Hill Road in West Pennant Hills to Old Northern Road in Dural. To accommodate forecast population growth in Sydney's north west and support the Cherrybrook Priority Precinct, upgrades to local road infrastructure are required to prevent an increase in travel time, congestion, and road accidents.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- **Expand road capacity to reduce congestion.**
- **Improve travel times and improve safety for all road users.**
- **Ensure forecast population-driven increases in travel demand are met.**
