Port Botany to Kingsford Smith Airport and Mascot

State/Territory: New South Wales

Proposed AG funding: \$10.0 million

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will investigate access and bottlenecks between the major international gateways of Kingsford Smith Airport, Port Botany, and the surrounding Sydney motorway network, and identify options to improve freight efficiency, reduce congestion and improve connectivity on the road network for all road users. This business case is expected to be funded on a 50:50 basis with the New South Wales Government.

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

Port Botany and Kingsford Smith Airport are critical international gateways that move people and goods across the region. The road network between these gateways and in the area experiences significant congestion. Increased capacity and improved connection would support growth in passenger, freight and commuter movements.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- **Improve connectivity between major freight infrastructure including airports, commercial and industrial areas.**
- **Reduce congestion and improved road safety and freight efficiency.**
