# Major Project Business Case Fund

## Brisbane North-West Transport Corridor

**State/Territory:** Queensland

**Proposed AG funding:** \$10.0 million

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The business case will consider a north western alternative corridor to Gympie Road to help provide a high-frequency public transport connection between Everton Park and Strathpine, improving local accessibility for northern growth areas.

The North West Transport Corridor originates near Gympie Road and Strathpine Station in the north and continues south through Bridgeman Downs, McDowall and Everton Park to connect with Alderley Station and Shand Street in Alderley.

The Australian Government will provide 50 per cent of the funding for this business case. Funding arrangements for the remainder to be determined in consultation with the proponent.

### PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

The existing Gympie Road (to the east of the North West Transport Corridor) experiences heavy traffic, particularly during peak periods.

### PROJECT BENEFITS

- **Reduce congestion and improve road safety for all road users.**
- **Improve accessibility, connectivity and travel times.**
