

Major Project Business Case Fund

Centenary Motorway Upgrade

State/Territory: Queensland Proposed AG funding: \$10.0 million

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The business case will look at options to upgrade the Centenary Motorway to improve the current design, enhancing safety, amenity and connectivity along the route.

This business case is expected to be jointly funded on a 50:50 basis with the Queensland Government.

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

The Centenary Motorway plays a critical role within the broader south east Queensland transport network by connecting the outer western, inner and northern suburbs of Brisbane and beyond to the trade coast region. The motorway's progressive development to date, and the population and economic growth in the connected regions, has led to a number of sub-optimal outcomes in the corridor in regards to safety, connectivity and amenity. Centenary Motorway Capacity has been listed as a priority initiative by Infrastructure Australia.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Improve travel times and road safety for all road users.
- Improve connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets.
