Problem Description

This project responds to the concerns of Mitchell services and trade businesses around limited customer access to the area, by providing an additional light rail stop.

The project involves modification of the existing Canberra Light Rail Stage 1 Project for the design and construction of an additional light rail stop.

The New Mitchell Light Rail Stop will be located at the intersection of Sandford Street-Morisset Road and Flemington Road.

The additional stop at Mitchell will be within walking distance of local businesses, increasing customer access and providing an alternative commuting option for local employers and their staff.

Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improve passenger rail services.
- Improve efficiency and network reliability.
- Improve connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets.
- Improve accessibility and connectivity.
- The project is expected to support six direct jobs.

Project Timelines

Construction to commence late 2020, and to be completed by early 2021

- This commitment will enable this project to commence one year ahead of schedule.
