## Northbourne Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Australian Capital Territory

### Australian Government Funding: \$5.0 million

### Problem Description

The existing road pavement on parts of Northbourne Avenue has deteriorated and needs major structural pavement works. This project covers works on:

- Macarthur Avenue to Mouat Street (Northbound)
- Condamine Street to Macarthur Avenue (Northbound)
- Mouat Street to Macarthur Avenue (Southbound)

It will involve milling the existing pavement surface and structural layer of pavement, remediating poor condition sub-surface areas and then reconstructing the road pavement.

Restoring Northbourne Avenue will reinstate structural integrity and improve the visual impact of entering the Nation's Capital after completion of the Light Rail project. Trench crossings, patches and damage on the pavement will be repaired with a consistent pavement surfacing without any visual detracting.

### Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improve road safety for all road users.
- Reduce congestion and improve travel times.
- Improve efficiency and network reliability.
- Improve connectivity between people with jobs and services, and goods with markets.
- Improve accessibility and connectivity of road networks.
- This project is expected to support 40 direct jobs.

### Project Timelines

Construction to commence mid 2020, and be completed by early 2021.

- This will enable this project to commence 2 years ahead of schedule.
