Problem Description

This package of works will upgrade roads across the Northern Territory to address identified road safety and fatigue management issues that contribute to vehicle crashes. The works will address safety and driver fatigue by improving intersection geometry, expanding road and lane capacity, installing safety features such as guardrails, lighting, tactile edging and pedestrian crossings, and upgrading rest areas. The improvements are designed to reduce fatalities and injuries resulting from vehicle crashes while maintaining or improving access and connectivity for goods, services and people.

Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks.

Project Timelines

Construction of the projects in this package will begin in September 2020 and is scheduled to be completed in June 2021.
