Gateway Motorway: Flyover
Queensland

Australian Government Funding: \$12.3 million

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Problem Description

The Gateway Motorway Flyover is a bridge located on the Gateway Motorway at Gympie Arterial Road, connecting the Gateway Motorway to the Bruce Highway northbound at Bald Hills. Over 40,000 vehicles travel northbound along the Gateway Motorway over this bridge every day.

The Queensland Department of Transport and Main Roads conducted structural inspections of the Gateway Motorway Flyover, which identified the need for further investigations of the northbound route. As a precautionary measure during these investigations, changes to road access conditions were implemented including restricting heavy vehicle access to the Gateway Motorway Flyover from September 2019.

Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improve road safety for all road users.
- Reduce congestion and improve travel times.
- Improve efficiency and network reliability.
- Improve accessibility and connectivity of road networks.
- This project is expected to support 114 direct jobs during the construction phase.

Project Timelines

Design of strengthening works for the bridge are currently underway and is expected to be complete by mid-2020. Construction is expected to begin in late 2020 and is expected to take 12 months.
