Tamborine-Oxenford Road: Howard Creek Upgrade Queensland

Problem Description

The Howard Creek Causeway on Tamborine-Oxenford Road is located approximately 11 kilometres west of Oxenford, between Brisbane and the Gold Coast. This project will upgrade the Howard Creek Causeway to improve the safety of the road alignment and intersection layout and increase flood immunity for all road users.

The project will involve:

- upgrading the existing pipe culverts to a multiple cell box culvert structure;
- widening the road approaches; and
- upgrading the Lanes Road and Colin Meagher Road intersections.

Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improve safety for all road users.
- Improve efficiency and network reliability.
- This project is expected to support 16 direct jobs during the construction phase.

Project Timelines

Construction is expected to commence in late 2020, and be complete by late 2021.
